WEST BENGAL POST-POLL VIOLENCE

PM dials gov, expresses concern over law & order

Mamata holds meeting amid reports of six deaths since announcement of result

West Bengal Governor Jagdeep Dhanraj on Tuesday said Prime Minister Narendra Modi called him and expressed anguish over the law and order situation in the state following reports of post-poll violence from several districts.

West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee on Tuesday held a meeting with the top administrative and police officers of the state on the post poll violence in the state, an official said.

In the meeting, which was held at Banerjee's Kallighat residence, she took stock of the situation, he told PTI.

The state has witnessed a number of incidents of violence since Sunday when the results of the assembly election was declared and rivals TMC and BJP have traded charges for it.

At least six people were killed in post poll violence in different parts of the state including one in the city, police said.

The BJP has alleged that TMC-backed gangs have killed a number of its workers, attacked its women members, vandalised houses, looted shops of the party members and ransacked party offices. TMC has denied the charges. The incidents prompted the Centre to seek a factual report from the government on incidents of attack on opposition workers.

"PM called and expressed his serious anguish and concern at alarmingly wrong law & order situation @MamataOfficial. I share grave concerns @PMOIndia given that violence vandalism, arson, loot, and killings continue unabated," Dhanraj wrote on Twitter.

RETURNING OFFICER'S DECISION FINAL: EC ON NANDIGRAM RESULTS

The Election Commission on Tuesday clarified on recounting at Nandigram assembly constituency, which saw a defibrator between TMC chief Mamata Banerjee and BJP's Suvendu Adhikari, saying that the decision taken by the returning officer is the final under the law.

Banerjee lost by 1,956 votes to former protegee-turned-BJP adversary Adhikari. On Monday, she had alleged that the returning officer did not order recounting of votes even after she demanded it as he feared for his life.

The commission said the returning officer acted strictly in accordance with the extant electoral laws, instructions and guidelines, according to media reports.

The West Bengal government has informed the commission that it has provided security to the returning officer of the Nandigram assembly constituency. The sources said the returning officer was provided security in person and at his home on the directors of the EC. AGENCIES

Kangana permanently removed from Twitter over West Bengal post

Twitter has permanently suspended actor Kangana Ranaout's account for repeated violations of rules, specifically its "Hateful Conduct and Abusive Behaviour" policy, the microblogging site said in a statement on Tuesday.

The 34-year-old actor's handle @KanganaTeam now displays the message, account suspended. Ranaout, known for her often inflammatory tweets, posted several messages following the Mamata Banerjee-led Trinamool Congress' win over the BJP in West Bengal and incidents of post-poll violence. Calling for President's Rule in the state, she also blamed Banerjee for the violence and called her unpalatable names.

"We've been clear that we will take strong enforcement action on behavior that has the potential to lead to violence. The referenced account has been permanently suspended for repeated violations of Twitter Rules specifically our Hateful Conduct policy and Abusive Behaviour policy," a Twitter spokesperson said.

The spokesperson added that the company enforces the Twitter Rules justly and impartially for everyone on its platform. When Twitter enforces such actions

like permanently suspending an account, it notifies people that they have been suspended for abuse violations, and explains which policy or policies they have violated and which content was in violation.

On Monday, writer-lyricist Hussain Haideri had shared two tweets of the actor and urged people to report the account.

SC strikes down law regulating realty sector in Bengal

The Supreme Court Tuesday struck down West Bengal's law on regulating real estate sector saying it was "unconstitutional" as the state's statute encroached upon the Centre's Real Estate (Regulation and Development) Act (RERA).

The top court also said that WB HIRA has failed to include valuable safeguards for the homebuyers. A Bench of justices D Y Chandrachud and M R Shah said the West Bengal Housing Industry Regulation Act (HIRA), 2017 is more or less identical to the Centre's RERA and hence repugnant to Parliament's law. UP panchayat polls: BJP loses in Ayodhya, rivals claim big wins

As counting of votes polled in the panchayat polls progressed across Uttar Pradesh, political parties on Tuesday claimed stalling performances, apparently taking advantage of the fact that these elections were not contested on party symbols.

A senior State Election Commission (SEC) official said Tuesday evening that counting of votes was likely to continue late into the night. He, however, could not specify on how many seats counting was underway.

The counting of votes began Sunday morning at more than 825 centres across the 75 districts of Uttar Pradesh. The BJP has claimed 918 party candidates while over 500 are elected for zilla panchayats while over 500 are elected for panchayat seats in Ayodhya, while the Samajwadi Party won 24.

The Samajwadi Party too claimed a big victory over the BJP in the polls. The SP

claimed it had won more than half of the posts in district panchayats, while alleging the administration was not handing over certificates to its candidates.

An SP office-bearer said it has so far won over 800 seats of district panchayat members (out of total 3,050). He alleged that BJP men are misusing official machinery and counting independent candidates as those supported by them.

Samajwadi Party supreme leader Akhilesh Yadav, meanwhile, on Tuesday claimed that it is the UP panchayat polls people gave first priority to his party and said that they did a tremendous job to save the democracy by electing his party candidates.
